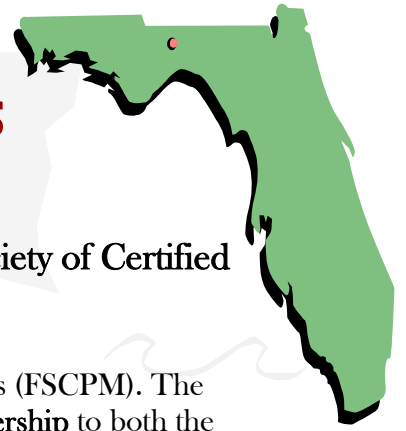


NFCPM MEMBER BENEFITS
